We have various volunteer opportunities available throughout the year and invite you to contact our volunteer coordinator if you would like to volunteer or have an idea for a project or an event to support True North.





Some volunteer positions will require different levels of training and security clearances. These include, but are not limited to, review and acceptance of True Norths volunteer policy and confidentiality agreements, volunteer orientation and training, basic domestic violence and family abuse training, FOIP training, criminal record checks, drivers abstract and child intervention checks.

INDIVIDUAL VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES.

Donation Room Support

Who: Adults that are able to lift up to 25lbs. and love to organize.

What: True North has donation spaces that require sorting, folding, cleaning, inventory and organization of donations that continuously arrive at True North. In order to best serve our families with their needs in shelter, an organized and inventoried donation space allows us to quickly and easily access what our families need and see what we are in low supply of.

When: Commitment would be between 2-8 hours per month. Our schedule is as

flexible as yours.

Where: Strathmore

Quilters

Who: Anyone with the time, talent and materials to create quilts or blankets.

What: Due to the years of support from various quilters and quilting groups, True North has been able to supply our families with blankets when they transition from shelter onto to their next step's. Blankets large enough for a twin, double or queen bed are of particular importance.

When: Ongoing

Toy Cleaners

Who: Youth ages 13+

What: We are committed to offering a clean and healthy environment for everyone in shelter. Children and toddlers spend plenty of time engaged in play which means that our toys need to be sanitized constantly. We are seeking community minded youth to help us with this task throughout the year but especially in the summertime.

When: Commitment would be 2-12 hours per month. Our schedule is flexible to accommodate a student's needs.

INDIVIDUAL VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES.

Event Volunteers

Who: Adults & youth

What: Tasks could include support with event/raffle/50/50 ticket sales, décor planning, event space set up (tables, chairs, place settings, décor etc.), event hosting support (door people, cleaners, bar tenders, auction support, event clean-up crew etc.)

When: Various times throughout the year.

Where: Strathmore and surrounding area

Fundraising/Event Committee Members

Who: Task oriented adults seeking to help raise funds and make a difference.

What: The True North fundraising committee is seeking community-minded, professional and organized adults to join our fundraising committee. This position involves attending fundraising meetings, planning of events, selling tickets, sourcing donations and advocating in the community.

When: The position is a minimum 1-year commitment. Duties and time commitments will fluctuate throughout the year based on event times and dates.

Where: Strathmore & Surrounding

Community Booth Support

Who: Professional and mature teens or adults willing to provide information about True North volunteer program to the public. The individual would need to be willing to spend time learning about family abuse and providing information in a professional and appropriate way.

What: True North hosts community information booths at many different types of events. The volunteer position would require the individual to attend 2-10 events throughout the year, with a minimum commitment of one year. Access to personal transportation is a requirement of this position.

When: Various times throughout the year, many events are held on weekends.

Where: Strathmore, Calgary and surrounding communities.

INDIVIDUAL VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES.

Wellness Support Volunteer

Who: Adults with wellness strategy skills are willing to share their time and talents with our families.

What: As part of the healing journey, True North promotes self-care and mindfulness strategies to all of our clients. This can look like art, paint nights, taichi, spa services, aromatherapy and more. We are seeking professional individuals that are willing to help us support our families in this way. The position is flexible and will require some training and background checks.

When: Various times throughout the year. Where: Strathmore and surrounding area

Residential Support Volunteer

Who: Adults to are able to lift about to 25lbs.

What: The residential support volunteer would be responsible to helping the crisis team with important tasks to keep the shelter operating smoothly. Tasks like photocopying, building toy and welcome baskets and bedmaking are a few of the items we are seeking your help with in this role.

When: We anticipate a time commitment of 2-12 hours per month.

Where: Strathmore

Events Rental Coordinator

Who: Adults with strong skills in organization, customer service and attention to detail. Basic knowledge of Microsoft Outlook and Excel are an asset. Access to transportation is required for this role.

What: True North has a small inventory of event décor that can be rented out for weddings, parties and other events by donation. We are seeking an individual to help us coordinate this new program. It would consist of taking calls and emails from prospective customers and facilitating the pickup and drop off of the décor items. Tasks include keeping a detailed inventory of items, facilitating rental agreements, meeting with customers at the rental site. The Event Rental Coordinator would receive support from True North Volunteer Coordinator.

When: Commitment would be dependent on popularity of this program. We anticipate 8 hours per month at this time. There is a one-year minimum commitment for this position.

Where: Strathmore and area.
