Based on their belief that all members of our community should be able to live without abuse or the threat of abuse, tenacious and caring community members came together in 1992 to create a Society dedicated to providing shelter, counselling and referral services to survivors of abuse without regard to their gender, age, race, religion, socioeconomic status, sexual orientation, marital status or mental or physical ability. True North Society (formerly Wheatland Crisis Society) opened its shelter in May of 1993, the first in Canada that provided shelter and other services to both male and female survivors of domestic abuse.

True North Society is committed to providing essential services such as short-term emergency shelter, community programming, education, supportive counselling, referral, and advocacy. We serve over 15 communities reaching as far as Three Hills, Drumheller, Siksika Nation and Chestermere.
